NRD Fence


We are all as disappointed as everyone about the installation of the NRD wire fence. The HOA reached out to the NRD this summer regarding the fence, however all fence communication stopped as the fence questions were being directed to the City of Omaha legal department. Based on conversations with the developer, they were unaware of the fence. The wire fence does not match the quality expected within Grandview Ridge. The HOA will continue to try to work with the SID and NRD regarding the fence.

NRD Trail

Now that the dam project is nearly complete, we are all excited to have the walking trail around the newly constructed NRD lake. The trail would be common to Grandview Ridge, Privada and Blue Sage. Unfortunately, based on the September 2020 SID board meeting, the status of the trail is on hold until the Privada development is further completed. The HOA will continue to push the SID's to complete the walking trail as promised. We've included a trail map that was provided to the NRD/City of Omaha in 2016.
